GERMI RESEARCH FELLOW SCHEME

1. Approach:

The GERMI Research Fellow Scheme aims to attract students of proven academic record towards research activities. The awardees are expected to work on research projects. Three Research Fellow positions are available in 2012-13. The awardees are expected to work in different Departments/ Centres based on their academic backgrounds. The awardees will be working in the research projects under the mentorship of Director GERMI / senior scientists. This will also provide a valuable opportunity for them to mainstream their work through sustained efforts over period of 12/24 months.

This Scheme is meant for full time research work at GERMI. They are open for candidates, preferably maximum age up to 35 years, who have obtained their Master's degree in the area geosciences and work related to of Hydrocarbon exploration, extraction, Renewable energy systems and allied energy sectors and any other related fields from a recognized university is essential. Applicant should have at least first-class master's degree with a minimum 60 per cent and should have completed at least 1 year of post Master's degree research experience. In case of those who are already employed under any project their applications should be routed through their supervisor. An advance copy of the application may be sent to GERMI for consideration.

2. How to apply:

The eligible Applicant may send the application (in the prescribed Proforma A: http://www.germi.org/downloads/Proforma-A-cv.pdf and Proforma B: http://germi.org/downloads/Proforma-B%20-detail-praposal.pdf) the Director. GERMI. to Completed application should include (1) Curriculum vitae (Proforma-A), including the list of publications, if any, (3) Proposed plan of Research work at GERMI (not exceeding 3 pages), (4) One 'Writing Sample' which could be an article or a scholarly paper published/presented in academic journals/conferences or extracts from the applicant's past academic work, (5) Two recommendations, of which one should be from the applicant's dissertation supervisor, and (6) Photocopy of the Educational certificate.

3. Procedure of Selection:

The applications received will be referred to the concerned subject matter division of GERMI and to a specialist in the discipline of the applicant for comments. The applications along with these comments will be considered for the selection.

4. Details of the Scheme

- The Research Fellow will be entitled to an honorarium of Rs.18,000/- per month. The honorarium paid to the Research Fellow shall be subject to the Income Tax Act, as per Government of India guidelines.
- They will be supported with a common local transport facility from the common location to work place and back.
- Health Insurance scheme will be provided to cover the candidate.
- GERMI will not provide accommodation facility.

5. Application Deadline & Notifications:

Applications can be sent by Speed/Registered post at any time with letters of recommendation by the concerned persons directly to GERMI by post indicating APPLICATION FOR 'GERMI RESEARCH FELLOW SCHEME 2012-13' on the cover. Selected candidates will be notified by email/post. All the applications are processed twice (May/December) in a year depends on the availability of the posts and requirements of GERMI but continue till the total number of vacancies are filled.
