GERMI ADJUNCT SCIENTIST SCHEME

1. Objectives of the Scheme:

'GERMI Adjunct Scientist' is an honorary position to the Scientist.

The objectives for GERMI Adjunct Scientist Scheme are multi-fold:

- 1. To create an opportunity for scientists working in other institutions to be associated with GERMI in its research projects even as they hold their position in their respective institutions.
- 2. Scientists associated on specific tasks for the external projects and their expenditure will be met from their externally funded projects.
- 3. Scientists can be specially invited to express their consent to be part of GERMI's initiatives through the arrangements stated above.
- 4. They may be associated through the whole duration of the project at GERMI or be assigned a specific role in the project. This could include review of proposals, assistance in developing proposals, contributing to reviews / reports.
- 5. Their CVs can be included in the core team listing of GERMI to strengthen GERMI's research scientist positions.

2. Approach

The scheme shall be open to scientists from Deemed universities, IIT's, Central Universities and state or central funded institutions/organizations like CSIR, engaged in energy research. Two Adjunct Scientist positions are available in 2012-13. They can visit GERMI on invitation to work for a short time. The period of visit is for a week upto a month. Their travel and stay expenses will be borne by GERMI. Preference will be given to the scientists who have served in GERMI or been associated with GERMI's research activities / proposals. They are therefore free to pursue their careers outside GERMI and be associated and assist GERMI. They may be associated even though the whole duration of the project or part of the project assigned for a specific role. This could include review of proposals, assistance in developing proposals, contributing to reviews / reports

Work experience in the areas of Hydrocarbon exploration, extraction, Renewable energy and allied energy sectors is essential.

3. How to apply:

The eligible scientist/ faculty may send their application or nomination in the prescribed Proforma to the Director, GERMI-RIIC. The applications will be received twice a year i.e. in the month of May /December for which a specific circular will be issued depending upon the vacancies. The applications received within the period specified in the circular will be entertained but continue till a suitable candidate is shortlisted.

4. Procedure of Selection:

The applications received will be referred to the concerned subject matter division of GERMI and to a specialist in the discipline of the applicant for comments. The applications along with these comments will be considered for the selection.

5. Details of the Scheme

- This is an honorary position for the individual.
- There will be no other honorarium, contingent grant or any other facilities extended to the GERMI Adjunct Scientist.
- The selected candidate's duration is for a period as per the requirement.
- However, as per project need, honorarium is possible.

6. Application Notifications:

Application or nomination can be sent by Speed/Registered post at any time with letters of recommendation by the concerned persons directly to GERMI by post indicating APPLICATION FOR 'GERMI ADJUNCT SCIENTIST SCHEME 2012-13' on the cover. Selected candidates will be notified by email/post.
